


VVN Marketplace








Challenge 1 Participation Plateau








VVN Registered Users Since November 2024

All Veterans	678,149	6,665
Global War on Terror Veterans	461,200 (68%)	3,994 (60%)
Vietnam Veterans	169,664 (25%)	241 (4%)
Army National Guard	7,250 (1%)	332 (4%)

Note: Many Veterans have served in multiple eras.



Challenge 2 Capacity for Care



- 52 service providers in Virginia offering 149 resources
- 68% of registered users have connected with services
- Proportionately align access to services with regional Veteran population
- Strategically increase services in line with Veteran needs



Fully functional online capability that the SMVF Community trusts as their single online point of access for community involvement and resources.

Vision:

- Member One Stop for all VDVS services (Integrate VVN Portal Marketplace with VDVS Service Lines)
- Easy and simple access with minimal registration requirements.
- Directly links member to other state agencies based on qualification. (i.e., Lifetime Fishing/Hunting Licenses).
- ➤ Personalization of the Member Home page, reducing duplication of effort in back-office operations and processes.
- Connecting with DoD and VA for seamless upload of forms (i.e. DD 214, etc) and claim status, Disability rating letters, GI Bill, etc.
- Assured viability through the next 5 years.
