• Number of agencies represented in responses: 16

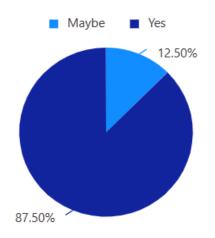
Numbers of individual responses received: 40

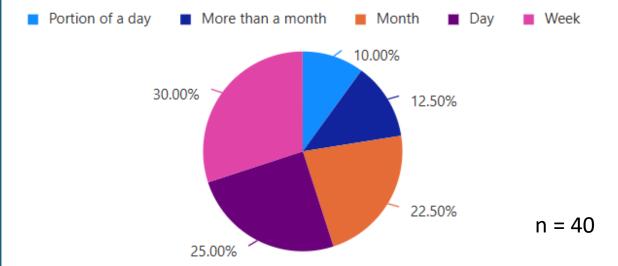
Research: Additional Key Survey Results

6. What duration do you believe is appropriate for to provide targeted assistance from one agency to another?

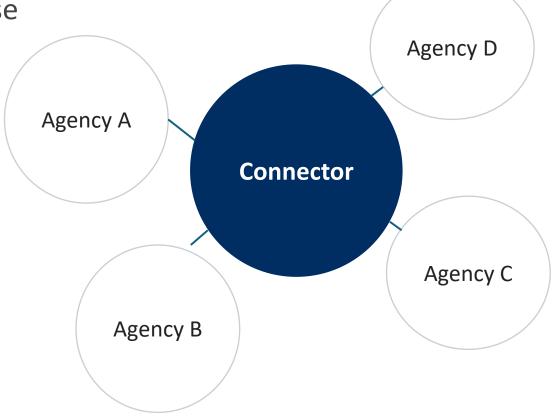

Outcome: DPOR IT chief provides direct engagement

LOANING – Curriculum Development

Scenario: Brightpoint CC finance lead retires, creating a gap in a critical process.

Outcome: J. Sargeant Reynolds CC loans its accounting manager

EXCHANGING – Regulatory Compliance

Scenario: DEQ and VDOT collaborate on stormwater inspections

Outcome: Shared best practices
