Program Design


Program Design


Job Shadow Programs at Other Universities


- Looked at 30 universities Job Shadow web presence (including VCU)

- Robust programs at: University of Maryland, UC Berkeley, Columbia, Georgetown







- Survey distributed to staff via TelegRAM

- Gauge interest and measure impact














Budget & Resources

Recommendations

Tiers of Engagement:

- Tier 1 Light / Casual Engagement (non-credit bearing)
 - Browse bios on job shadow website
 - Attend an information session on the job shadow program
 - Informational meetings with staff of interest
 - Casual shadow experience (half or full day)
- Tier 2 Medium / Casual to Serious Engagement (non-credit or credit bearing)
 - Browse bios, information session, multiple informational meetings, and casual shadow experiences
 - A full day shadow as a class assignment
- Tier 3 Heavy / Serious Engagement (credit bearing)
 - REAL 399 (0-3 credits), as Internship credit through the student's major department (1-3 credits), or as a REAL Co-curricular experience
